Pharmacovigilance: An Overview

The aim of pharmacovigilance is to protect public health by identifying, evaluating and minimizing safety issues to ensure that the overall benefits of medicines outweigh the risks. However, the recent withdrawal from the market of certain medicines has focused attention on pharmacovigilance approaches; raised concerns about improving the existing pharmacovigilance framework; and highlighted the need to ensure consistency among international regulations governing the reporting of side effects ("Adverse Drug Reactions" - ADRs). In drug regulation problems related to the safety and quality of drugs exists in many places. Effective drug regulation is required to ensure the safety, efficacy and quality of drugs, as well as the accuracy and appropriateness of the drug information available to the public. Regulation of drugs encompasses a variety of functions like licensing, inspection of manufacturing facilities and distribution channels, product assessment and registration, adverse drug reaction (ADR) monitoring, QC, control of drug promotion and advertising, and control of clinical drug trials.

Pharmacovigilance plays an important role in ensuring the safety of medications through the detection, assessment, and understanding of the adverse impact of pharmaceutical products.

The most influential pharmacovigilance activity is the spontaneous reporting by healthcare practitioners (such as physicians, pharmacists, and nurses) of suspected ADRs that had not been identified during premarketing clinical trials.



#### Importance of Pharmacy Practice in Daily Life

A Pharmacist is also known as a chemist or a druggist as health care professionals who practice in pharmacy and deal with the field of medicine. They provide proper medication and are also involved in the field of preparation, standardization, formulation, quality checking, inspection, compounding, and dispensing of the different types of drug of several dosage forms in such a way the medication preferable for a simplified route of administration in the treatment of local as well as chronic diseases. Pharmacists are healthcare professionals who worked in a wide variety of health care systems such as in the pharmaceutical industry for innovation (R&D), formulation, manufacturing, processing, quality checking, and maintaining proper safety and toxicity parameters. Pharmacists are involved in patient education and worked in collaboration with physicians and other health care professionals for the prevention of disease and the treatment of patients. The importance of the pharmacy is in different fields and fundamental characteristics of involvement in day-to-day life. It plays a role to assure patient benefits from rational evidence-based medication and improvement of patient care. There is a need for a system of assuring the integrity of the medicine supply chain to assure the value of medicines used very important role during the Covid19 pandemic

# India's Position In The Global Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (Api) Market

Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs) are the founding block of strategic architecture in the pharmaceutical value chain. More importantly, APIs provide therapeutic effect of a medicine and, are, therefore, the central innovation and, more often, the critical intellectual property that drives the industry.

The Indian pharmaceutical industry ranks among the top five in terms of production volume, accounting for approximately 8.5% of global output. Turnover has increased from approximately US\$ 0.3 billion in 1980 to approximately US\$ 18 billion last year, with an estimated global market value of US\$ 53 billion.

Low labour costs and innovation are two major factors driving this growth. India is the Asia-Pacific region's third largest active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) market, and China as its main supplier.

Dependence on China for APIs has been a big concern for the Indian pharma industry. From 0.5 per cent in 1987, the percentage of API imports from China shot up to around 78 per cent in 2020. India imports approximately 55 per cent of its API needs, and almost all imports are from China. Scale, subsidies, cheaper capital with cost of four-to-five per cent versus 12-15 per cent in India, lower logistics cost (0.9 per cent versus four per cent in India), cheaper power, all work to China's advantage.

Several Indian companies have moved their requirement of APIs, KSMs (key starting materials) and intermediates to Indian manufacturers who have ramped up their capacity rapidly to cater to this uptick in demand. Nevertheless, the dependence on China for basic chemicals continues.

Post-COVID, the Indian pharma industry is at an inflexion point. It is envisaged, that the contribution of pharma to the GDP will grow to 4.5 -5 per cent from 1.8 per cent, at present.

Pharma is one unique sector where the consumer is not the decision maker and the decision maker is not the payer. It is unique in another sense, that there is no product obsolescence.

Aspirin, paracetamol and metformin still continue to be gold standards of front line therapy. Hence, scale, quality, compliance and process excellence shall drive growth.

China and India are driving the market growth through their cost advantages and have emerged as manufacturing hubs for the APIs. With government support, improving IP systems and manufacturing standards in China & India, APIs market in Asia-Pacific is expected to grow steadily in the coming years. In the near future India may beat China in global active pharmaceutical ingredients market.

The company's sales surged 44.1% in 2020 they are responsible for 83.2% of all book music and video e-commerce purchase in the U.S.

The food and personal care industry saw the highest growth in the e-commerce space in 2020, according to data from date peportal. Globally the e-commerce revenue in this category was up more than 40% and grocery stores, online transactions in November 2020 were double the January 2020.
